We cordially invite you to participate and take an active part in the "12th Biennial Congress of the European Shock Society" to be held in Ulm, Germany, on September 14–16, 2006.

Scientifically, the last decade has led to new information about potential genetic impacts on the mechanisms of both the development and the outcome of trauma, shock and sepsis. The question whether this knowledge may result in innovative therapeutical approaches to mitigate shock/sepsis in the clinical setting is the subject of intensive investigation. Members of the European Shock Society can be proud to have contributed key research to this scientific challenge.

Our conferences help improve and disseminate knowledge by providing a diversified forum for open discussion and scientific interchange. The sustained efforts and valuable research interactions between experts in the fields related to trauma, shock and sepsis – whether or not they are ESS members – play an equally important role. The scientific program of the upcoming conference has been designed to attract a broad audience and will encompass a wide range of topics from basic sciences to the clinical experience in the fields of trauma, shock and sepsis. The spectrum will include all modern aspects of cell biology, pathophysiology, intensive care and clinical studies, as well as future views of technology and therapeutical strategies.

Free paper sessions, symposia and workshops will be offered in order to integrate basic research with (possible) clinical applications from the genetic basis, to molecular and organ levels and the whole organism. Furthermore, keynote lectures will provide deeper insights into the complex biological reactions to trauma, shock and sepsis. Poster sessions will give opportunity for personal scientific interchange and discussion. In keeping with the Society's tradition, the Young Investigator Award competition based on the highest-scored abstracts will be presented. Last but not least, an industrial inhibition will be the platform for joint interests of research, development and clinical application.

We are convinced that Ulm will impress congress participants with its mixture of medieval charm and modern flair. What's more, there will be ample opportunity to meet old and make new friends in a familiar international atmosphere.
